Chairperson Councillor Berry is actively engaging in a workshop arranged by Wyre Cllr Peter Cartridge involving the Deputy Police and Crime Commissioner for Lancashire Constabulary and all relevant agencies for parish council to discuss various options. Discussions included SPiDs (Speed Indicator Devices), child or traffic policeman dummies (that can be located near schools or busy stretches of road), and school eduction on road safety. So with all this concentrated effort, we look forward to seeing some positive action taking place on our roads in the near future.
