NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Lewth Lane, Catforth from a point outside Melrose to a point outside Wrainhow House.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on 13th February 2024 until 1700 hours on 16th February 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Hollowforth Lane – Eaves Lane – Cuddy Hill – Rapley Lane – Sowerby Road – Woods Lane – Carrs Green

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Plus on behalf of Electricity North West to install a new customer connection.
