## LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(PRESTON ROAD, INSKIP WITH SOWERBY, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council intends to make an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Preston Road, Inskip with Sowerby from its junction with Hornby Lane to its junction with Pinfold Lane.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 hours on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> September 2024 until 1530 hours on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> October 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. Pedestrian access to properties will always be maintained.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Watery Gate Lane – White House Lane – Brock Road – Moss Lane – Pinfold Lane

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Section 50 HV cable laying works to be carried out by Energetics Design and Build.
