

### 3. About Homes

This section and first/covering page of this consultation asserts that “our plan should support and complement our planning authority” this statement implies that irrespective of the views of the residents this plan should support whatever WBC wishes. That is not democracy that is dictatorship that seeks to proscribe from the outset the outcome of the NP and in my view is unacceptable.

Parish, District, County Councillors, Council Officers, MPs' and Civil Servants need to be reminded that they are in office to serve and not to dictate to the electorate.

Therefore, this NP should reflect the wishes of the residents of the parish and not what WBC, LCC or the Government want. If the consensus of the majority of the residents are in favour of additional housing then so be it but if the residents are not in favour then the NP should be drafted and submitted and should oppose any housing development within the parish. I am heartily fed up with the electorate being ignored by elected members, officers, MPs' and Civil Servants.

In July 2018 the British government signed the UN Global Migration Compact (for the safe orderly and **regular** migration) without the consent of the British people. The UN deliberately entitled this document a Compact instead of a Treaty so as to avoid it having to be approved by the parliaments of the signatory nations deliberately to avoid scrutiny. As a result, this and the previous government have no intention of restricting either legal or illegal immigration into the UK. As a result the UK, because of its overly generous welfare provision has become the destination of choice for legal and illegal economic refugees and their families resulting in additional pressure on housing.

The signing of the Global Migration Compact, the resultant influx of illegal and legal migrants and the pressure upon Local Authorities by central government to force parishes like Inskip with Sowerby to accept at least 150 new houses in an area where there is no indigenous demand for more housing is not in the best interests of the parish and should be resisted.

We all survive upon the top six inches of soil, the natural water supply and what swims in the sea, to destroy farm or potential farming land is just plain stupid because it increases food insecurity locally and nationally.
